Watts History Project (WHP) Update

The WHP was started by two very industrious Watts faculty, Donna Rogers and Betty Jean Faulkner. They did incredible work and amassed a huge collection of items from metal bedpans and urinals, to dolls dressed in the first uniform with a shawl and leg-o-mutton sleeves, to china and silver used for teas, to Black Banding program in 1957, capping exercise program in 1937 and graduation program in 1929. There are newspaper articles and pictures of graduates beginning in the late 1890s.

Many scrapbooks, starting in 1936 are included. This is just a very small amount of what we have. You can imagine the fragility of some of the holdings. For this reason, we plan to digitize as much as possible to preserve the materials and to make them available to you online, as we did with all the annuals several years ago. UNC helps with digitizing which could be very costly. Unfortunately, the WCON did not have room to store the collection when they moved. We have gotten a storage bin and moved all holdings in early October. What an undertaking!!!Thanks to the WCON to help pay the monthly storage cost. Consider donating to the WHP to help cover these costs.
