Watts History Project Update

There is very little to report at this time. A cape was left at the school at the end of 2023. We currently have many capes. Please consider donating items i.e., pictures, Black Banding and Graduation Programs, newspaper articles, and other memorabilia. There are many of these in the collection; however, there are missing items from many classes.

Work on the recommendations of the Historical Consultant has halted until the new School of Nursing site has been selected. Several of the recommendations centered around consolidation of holdings into 1-2 rooms versus the current 3 locations. Much has been moved but remaining will not be done until we know more about location and actual space available to the Watts History Project. The creation of several new policies was also recommended; however, we must wait to see space and determine specifics. In an effort to consolidate and preserve very old holdings, especially newspaper articles, we will be working with UNC to digitalize additional holdings. If you recall, all annual yearbooks were digitalized several years ago and are available on-line to all. UNC has offered to do additional materials. The most 'at risk' materials will be selected first.

Thank you for your support of the Watts History Project and special thanks again to Donna Rogers and Betty Faulkner for their vision and the incredible time and effort that went into the creation of the massive holdings.

Dr. Ruth Cox Scholarship


